By car:

- Consider carpooling!
- GPS: Quartier Genas, 26500 Bourg-lès-Valence.
- A7 motorway, exit 14, towards Grenoble, then take exit 36 "Bourg-lès-Valence, le Plateau".
- A49 motorway, ring road towards Marseille, exit 3, towards "Lyon, Bourg-lès-Valence", then take exit 36 "Bourg-lès-Valence, le Plateau".
- From the Tech&Bio car park, a free shuttle leaves every two minutes to bring you to the trade fair.

By train:

from the Valence TGV and Valence Ville railway stations, located just 10 minutes from Tech&Bio, a free shuttle service will bring you to the trade fair.

By bus:
